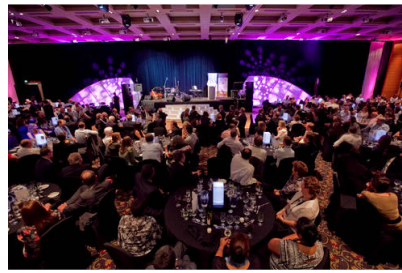

## Overview

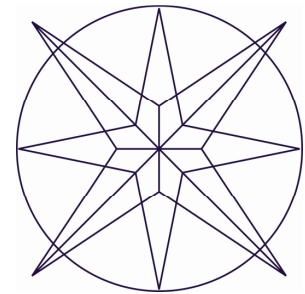
The Australian Public Sector Anti-Corruption Conference 2011 (APSACC) is a joint initiative of Australia's three major anti-corruption agencies: *The Corruption and Crime Commission (CCC)*, *Crime and Misconduct Commission (CMC)* and the *Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC)*.

The Conference was a high profile event within the anti corruption industries across Australia and attracted delegates from within Australia and internationally from 20 countries. The event was widely acclaimed, due mainly to the high calibre of the presenters and speakers and provided delegates with a unique opportunity to focus on the latest trends, strategies and future directions in preventing corruption.

## The Role of International Conferences and Events (ICE)
